CHAPTER 1 OBJECTIVE AND PANEL COMPOSITION The scanning studys objective was to review and document innovative techniques, materials, procedures, and equipment used in the host countries for pavement preservation and to evaluate these elements for potential application in the United States. To this end, the panel met with government agencies and private-sector organizations involved with pavement preservation, as well as visited sites to observe firsthand the results of pavement preservation techniques and strategies. The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), an agency of the U. S. Department of Transportation, the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO), and the National Cooperative Highway Research Program (NCHRP) jointly sponsored the Pavement Preservation International Scanning Study.
