That son, when he became player and dramatist, assumed the name of Moliere. Until he was fourteen years old his education was neglected. His father sought to direct his mind to upholstery, and secured for him succession to his own Court office of valet de chambre tapissier. The boy had a grandfather who liked comedy, and who took him sometimes to the plays at the Hotel de Bourgogne. In 1543, when Francis I. ordered the sale and demolition of the Hotel de Bourgogne, and other houses, the players bought it, to build, at their own cost, a theatre upon its site. They opened it in 1548, but were no longer allowed to act plays on the mysteries of religion. They had among their farces Patelin, born in the fifteenth century, forefather of Tartufe.
